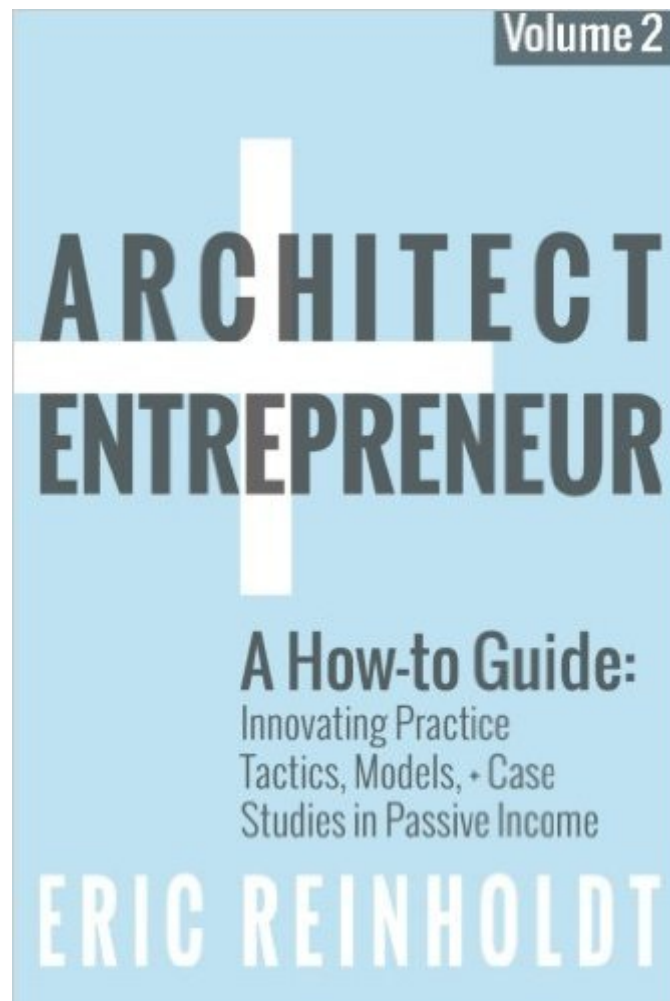

He is on the bleeding edge of changing the way business is done in Architecture, and I personally am going all in on what he calls the "Chassis Model" (Read the book to find out more!). A + E volume 2 is packed full of actionable tips, suggestions, work-flows, and ideas on ways to generate a passive income stream to supplement your active income streams as a designer.
